Please verify with a check mark by each item

- Application is complete and attached.
- Official high school transcript is attached.
- Copy of ACT or SAT scores is attached if not included on high school transcript.
- Two letters of recommendation are on letterhead, signed and are attached.
 - One from high school teacher/Guidance Counselor
 - One from another school official or personal reference
- Personal essay (1 page, double spaced, 250 words or less) to include information about themselves, their interests, academic and social achievements and a statement of their educational expectations for their future is attached.
- Color photo of themselves which will be used in TAHRA publications if awarded a Scholarship is attached.
- The sponsoring housing authority should submit **2 copies** of the scholarship application including supporting documentation. If awarded a scholarship, the grades have to be submitted to TAHRA each semester with current address. If student changes schools, this needs to be submitted to TAHRA with address of new school. TAHRA needs name & phone number of a contact at your housing authority.

- The Executive Director must initial the following indicating that the Housing Authority will be responsible for travel if necessary if asked to speak at TAHRA conference.** _____

INFORMATION and INSTRUCTIONS
2018-2019

The Tennessee Association of Housing and Redevelopment Authorities (TAHRA) Scholarship Program offers funds to outstanding students who reside in a public housing authority program (including Section 8 programs) based on academic merit, special talents or accomplishments, and need. Scholarships awards are made without regard to race, creed, religious preferences, sex or any other factor. The TAHRA scholarship program is done in cooperation with the SERC-NAHRO scholarship program.

Factors which are considered in the evaluation of scholarship applications include personal statement, leadership experience, class rank, test scores, grades, extracurricular activities, work experience, awards and recognition and community service.

The scholarship awards is \$1500 per academic year for **full time students** and is renewable each semester contingent upon full time enrollment with a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Resident of a public housing authority or assisted housing for a minimum of twelve months prior to January 1, 2018 and must reside in Public Housing or Section 8 to continue receiving the scholarship.
 - High school graduate, GED graduate or expect to graduate by June 2018.
 - Any applicant entering college may apply regardless of age.
 - Must have a 2.5 or better GPA on 4.0 scale.
 - Housing authority must be member in good standing with TAHRA.
 - The recipient must be planning to enroll in an accredited college as first time freshman in 2018 fall semester. This includes any accredited university, college, community college, vocational, technical or business school.
 - Application must be complete and postmarked by due date of **April 2, 2018**.

DEADLINE:

Scholarship application deadline is **April 2, 2018**. All applications must be received or postmarked by that date for consideration. Applications received after that date will not be considered.
